## **BASIC RISK MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT**

This agreement is to be read and signed by all new members and members renewing their membership each year without exception.

Those attending classes and workshops where dangerous practices are carried out, such as cutting glass, handling chemicals such as dyes and glazes etc, or operating potentially dangerous machinery or tools must wear eye protection. In the case of chemical and glaze mixing, respiratory protection must also be worn. The supply of this protection is the responsibility of the individual but students will be advised of the most appropriate types.

Under no circumstances are persons to enter the studio spaces wearing anything but closed in footwear.

Children in the studio areas must be under effective adult control.

No person shall bring onto, or allow to remain on Territory Craft premises, any animal for which they are responsible (Guide & hearing dogs excepted).

Persons wishing to operate power tools and machinery at Territory Craft premises must be able to demonstrate proficiency in the operation of that equipment.

Smoking and the consumption of alcohol in the studio/office/gallery areas, as well as the use of recreational or illicit-drugs anywhere on Territory Craft premises is strictly forbidden.

No food or drink is to be consumed in the defined studio areas of Territory Craft.
